LUKE BRYAN CONCERT INFORMATION
(Information for affected residents in the immediate area)



As most of you know by now, on Friday September 28, 2018, the Luke Bryan Farm Tour will be hosting a concert on 300N at the northwest corner of 1000E. This concert is a significant undertaking for many in Champaign County. We want to give you a portion of the timeline for the event, traffic patterns for the event and road closures.

Personnel from the Luke Bryan Farm Tour will begin arriving in the area late evening on September 27 and the early morning on September 28. Road closures in the area starting at about 7:00 a.m. on September 28th will include:

- 250N from the west edge of Pesotum to just west of the I-57 overpass
- 900E between 250N and 500N
- 400N between 900E and 1000E
- Route 45 between 300N and 600N

If you live on these roads that are closed, please make sure that if you leave the area, you have identification on your person when you return so that you can produce that to personnel manning the barricades at the above-mentioned roadways.

We want to do all that we can to keep the majority of the vehicular traffic to a few select roads. For patrons going to the event that are coming from the north, they will be directed west on 600N from Route 45. They will then be directed to 1000E where they will travel southbound to the parking lot areas between 300N and 400N. For patrons going to the event that are coming from the south, they will be directed to 300N where they will turn westbound. They will then travel to 1000E where they will turn northbound to the parking lot areas.

Patrons will be allowed to access the parking lot area at about 2:00 p.m. The concert will start at about 7:00 p.m. and will conclude at 11:00 p.m. We hope to have the vehicular traffic cleared from the area before 1:00 a.m. Luke Bryan Farm Tour personnel expect to be out of the area during the early morning hours of the 29th but will still have some personnel at the location cleaning up.

You will see several different police agencies assisting the Champaign County Sheriff's Office. The Illinois State Police will be handling the majority of the traffic posts. The Urbana and University of Illinois Police Departments will also be assisting at the concert venue.

The Champaign County Sheriff's Office and the Luke Bryan Farm Tour personnel want this event to bring a positive image to your neighborhoods.
