

**Village of Tolono Board of Trustees  
Regular Meeting  
April 17, 2018**

The Village of Tolono Board of Trustees ("Board") met on April 17, 2018. President Rob Murphy called the meeting to order at 6:34pm. Roll call found the following trustees present: Vicki Buffo, Jared Ping, Terrence Stuber and Gary Trulock. Trustees Anna Morris and Ryan Perry were absent. Also present were Clerk Brandy Dalton, Public Works Superintendent Matt Graven and attorney Marc Miller.

President Murphy led the Pledge of Allegiance. Terrence Stuber gave the invocation.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS**

-Taylor Richardson spoke about his water/sewer bill that was too high. Dalton told the Board that it was re-checked, all of the reads fall into line with each previous read and there was not a leak indication when the meter has been checked. The Board told Richardson his bill stands, but they will waive the late fee.

-Rick Smith, a resident, offered his assistance with bringing fiber to Tolono. He also stated that he wants to see the Park District preserved.

-David McCleary talked about the state of the property at 105 E Daggy. The trees are falling on his fence and into his yard. The Village attorney will try to get permission from the owner to go on the property to trim trees.
