## Did you know?

- ◆ The first St. Patrick's Day Parade took place in New York in the 1760s.
- ◆ Wear blue on St. Patrick's Day – For many years, blue was the color most associated with St. Patrick's Day. Green was considered unlucky. St. Patrick's blue was considered symbolic of Ireland for many centuries and the Irish Presidential Standard is still blue.
- ◆ Every year in Chicago, the Plumbers Local 110 union dyes the river "Kelly" green. The dye lasts for about five hours.
