The Village of Tolono Board of Trustees ("Board") met on October 15, 2019. President Rob Murphy called the meeting to order at 6:31pm. Roll call found the following trustees present: Rena Anderson, Vicki Buffo, Ryan Perry, Jared Robbins and Terrence Stuber. Trustee Jared Ping was absent. Also present were Interim Police Chief Justin Levingston, Public Works Superintendent Matt Graven and Clerk Brandy Dalton.

REPORTS

Public Works:
