I wanted to let everyone know what the next few weeks look like in Tolono.

The Village office will remain closed to the public through **May 31, 2020**.

Office staff will continue to work from home visiting the office briefly to process water payments and other miscellaneous tasks as they arise. Please call our office Monday-Friday, 8:00AM-5:00PM, if you have questions, concerns, or emergency needs. You may also send us an email at info@tolonoil.us.

Maintenance Staff will operate as usual to keep the Village running smoothly. Please avoid approaching the Village workers. If it is urgent that you speak with them person to person, practice safe distancing.

Water/Sewer bills will be mailed April 30, 2020. Residents may use the drop boxes located outside the Village Hall at 507 W Strong Street or the parking lot of TraxSide, corner of W Holden St and N Vorcey St to drop off payments. Residents may also visit the Village's website at <https://www.tolonoil.us> to set up online bill payments through PSN or contact their financial institution to set up payments through their bill pay service. We offer payment by phone too.

Everyone is ready to get out and get going in their golf carts. Please feel free to do so even if you have not renewed your sticker. We will extend last year's permits through

June 1, 2020. If you have never owned a golf cart and recently purchased one, you may drive without a permit through June 1, 2020.

Seasonal and pool meters are available. Please call the office to make an appointment to get yours and remember to wear a mask, per the new guidelines.

The village parks remain closed. Enjoy the open space but avoid the playground equipment. Restrooms are closed to the public.

Our hometown businesses need our help. Please consider ordering from one of our great eateries. Curbside services are being offered.

Check on your neighbors, especially our senior citizens and those with medical disabilities. If these citizens need help picking up groceries or prescriptions, please call our office. We will be glad to lend a hand!
