

**Village of Tolono Board of Trustees
Regular Meeting
April 21, 2020**

The Village of Tolono Board of Trustees ("Board") met on April 21, 2020. President Robert Murphy called the meeting to order at 6:28pm. Roll call found the following trustees present: Ryan Perry (video), Jared Ping an, Jared Robbins. Trustee Terrence Stuber arrived at 6:31pm and Trustee Vicki Buffo arrived at 7:25pm (video). Also present was Clerk Brandy Dalton (video).

All stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

REPORTS

Engineers:

Motion by Ping, second by Robbins to approve the Donohue task order for MFT engineering. Roll call: Perry, yes; Ping, yes; Robbin, yes; Stuber, yes.

Public Works:

Motion by Stuber, second by Ping to approve the MFR Resolution for \$220,000. Roll call: Perry, yes; Ping, yes; Robbins, yes; Stuber, yes. Motion passed.

-The dump clean-up by R & R Services will be places in the next budget, as well as the Broadway Street & Reynolds Street water main replacements.

Motion by Robbins, second by Pink to approve the quote up to \$4800 from Bob Brown Construction to grind the millings. Roll call: Perry, yes; Ping, yes; Robbins, yes; Stuber, yes. Motion passed.

Motion by Ping, second by Robbins to approve Ordinance 2020-O-9, amending the burn ordinance to allow the Village to burn at the dump. Roll call: Perry, yes; Ping, yes; Robbins, yes; Stuber, yes. Motion passed.

-Trustee Perry has been researching trench burners. He will get that information to the Board.

Motion by Ping, second by Stuber to approve the quote of \$5800 from Davis Houk Mechanical to replace 15 larger water meters. Roll call: Perry, yes; Ping, yes; Robbins, yes; Stuber, yes. Motion passed.

Police:

-Chief Levingston is looking into a grant for the body cameras that may pay after the fact.

Treasurer:

Motion by Ping, second by Robbins to approve the bills as presented. Roll call: Perry, yes; Ping, yes; Robbins, yes; Stuber, yes. Motion passed.

APPROVAL OF PRIOR MINUTES

Motion by Ping, second by Stuber to approve the minutes of the regular session meetings, held April 7, 2020. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

Trustee Robbins asked what the suggestions were for complaints against the Village President. It was also discussed about adding a section for emergency Village shut-downs. He will compile everything and get it to the Board for the next meeting.

There were 2 companies that provided numbers for the refinance of TIF Bonds. The savings were based on the numbers today, but it will fluctuate a lot between now and September when we are able to refinance.

Motion by Stuber, second by Robbins to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement with Champaign County Animal Control. Roll call: Perry, yes; Ping, yes; Robbins, yes; Stuber, yes. Motion passed.

NEW BUSINESS

Motion by Ping, second by Robbins to approve Ordinance 2020-O-10 as discusses with changes, regulating yard waste disposal by the Village. Roll call: Perry, yes; Ping, yes; Robbins, yes; Stuber, yes. Motion passed.

Motion by Robbins, second by Ping to reduce the Liquor License fee for locally owned businesses by 3 months and removing the fee for the Outdoor Café portion of the license for Fiscal Year 2021. Roll call: Buffo, abstain; Perry, yes; Ping, yes; Robbins, yes; Stuber, abstain. Motion passed.

MISCELLANEOUS

There was an email from a resident asking about a Village clean-up day. We normally do them every-other year. Last year was the year we were supposed to have it, but it got cut because of the budget deficit. We will have to look into possibly having it this year.

There has been concerns about the recycling bins always being full. Trustee Ping asked Clerk Dalton to contact ABC to get records of bin pick-ups. We will also add signage to state that the service is for Village of Tolono residents only.

There was discussion around selling the water and sewer systems or raising the rates.

Motion by Ping, second by Stuber to adjourn the meeting at 7:43pm.
