

**Village of Tolono Board of Trustees
Regular Meeting
April 6, 2021**

The Village of Tolono Board of Trustees (“Board”) met on April 6, 2021 with some members present at the meeting room in the Police Station, located at 205 E. Main St., Tolono, IL and some members present via video/audio. President Robert Murphy called the meeting to order at 6:32pm. Roll call found the following trustees present: Vicki Buffo (via video), Ryan Perry, Jared Robbins, and Terrence Stuber. Trustee Jared Ping arrived at 7:26pm. Also present was Clerk Brandy Dalton, Public Works Superintendent Scott Arbuckle and Police Chief Justin Levingston.

All stood for the Pledge of Allegiance. Trustee Stuber gave the invocation.

PUBLIC COMMENTS
