

**Village of Tolono Board of Trustees
Regular Meeting
June 1, 2021**

The Village of Tolono Board of Trustees ("Board") met on June 1, 2021 in the Police Station, located at 205 E. Main St., Tolono, IL. President Robert Murphy called the meeting to order at 6:30pm. Roll call found the following trustees present: Vicki Buffo, Ann Jack Haluzak, Ryan Perry, and Jared Robbins. Trustee Kyle Hayden and Terrence Stuber were absent. Also present was Clerk Brandy Dalton, Public Works Superintendent Scott Arbuckle and Police Chief Justin Levingston.

All stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Tom Swigart was present to discuss his TIF application, which consisted of \$30,000 for a new roof and \$17,000 for asphalt drive work.

REPORTS

Engineering – Larry Johnson sent Clerk Dalton an email this evening with a copy of the Wastewater NPDES permit application that was sent in. It will renew within the next 6 months. The IEPA made public the Intended Use Plan last week. Tolono is on the list and the interest rates have dropped ¼% to 1.11%. We are eligible for a 20-year water loan and 30-year wastewater loan. The CCR draft is done and was given to Scott Arbuckle to look over.

Public Works – 2 of the summer help employees started today. Next week Scott will get with contractors for sidewalks, employees will be re-painting fire hydrants, and they plan to start burning the brush Monday weather permitting. There are plans to re-do the front of Village Hall.

Police Department – The department is scheduled to do annual qualification shooting on June 2. Officer Garcia will be ready to start training at that point. May was busy, and there was burglary to motor vehicles again.

Treasurer – The Public Hearing for the Appropriations Ordinance will be held at the next meeting, and will be on the agenda to approve.
