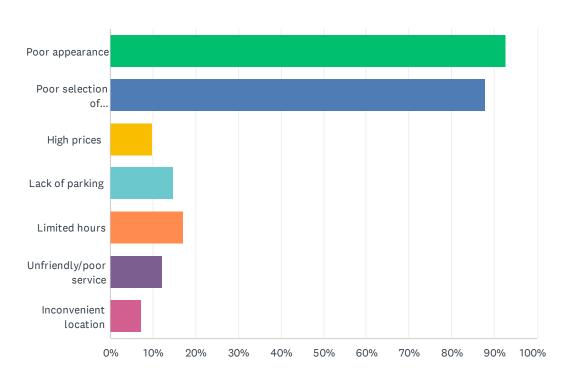

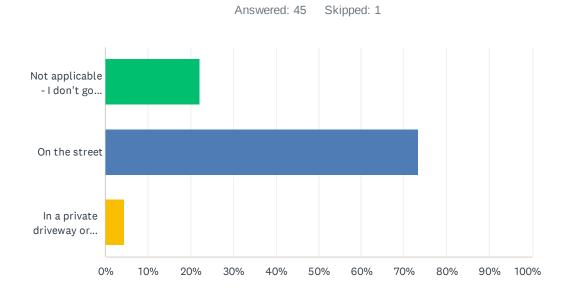
Q4 What are the major DISADVANTAGES of shopping or doing personal errands in the downtown? (Check all that apply)





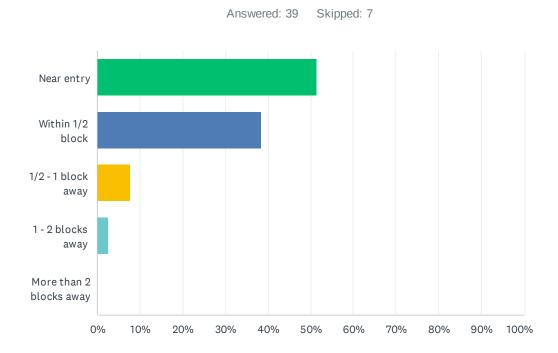

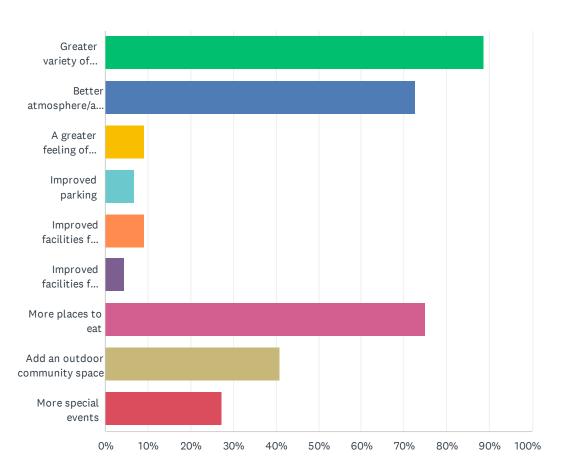

Q16 What is your gender?

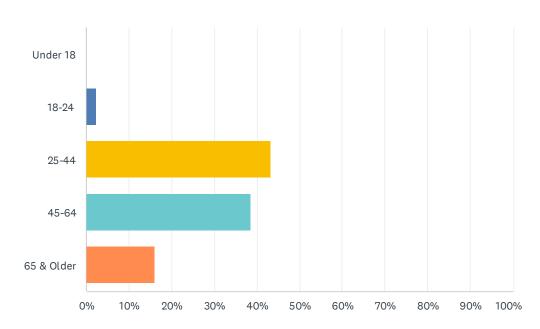
