

**Village of Tolono Board of Trustees  
Regular Meeting  
June 21, 2022**

The Village of Tolono Board of Trustees (“Board”) met on June 21, 2022 in the Police Station, located at 205 E. Main St., Tolono, IL. Trustee Terrence Stuber called the meeting to order at 6:34pm in the absence of President Rob Murphy. Roll call found the following trustees present: Ann Jack Haluzak, Kyle Hayden, and Terrence Stuber. Trustees Vicki Buffo and Jared Robbins were absent. Also present was Clerk Brandy Dalton.

All stood for the Pledge of Allegiance. Trustee Stuber gave the invocation.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Gary Mitchell gave a presentation of some conceptual drawings for the block of Main to Holden streets from Vorcey to Bourne streets. The space on the block isn’t owned yet, but most owners are open to negotiations. He also talked about getting contact information for the railroad to talk to them about a railroad park.

Marcia Gates talked about how she likes some of the graffiti on the train cars, and if we get a railroad park, it would be neat to see something like that at the park.

**REPORTS**

**Engineers** – Larry Johnson said that IDOT approved the MFT bid so work should start shortly. He spoke about the 3 workorders that are ongoing, which are the Zoning map update, the annual MS4 report on the storm sewer system, and the Safe Routes to School Program.

**Treasurer** – Brandy Dalton gave an update on the annual audit.

**Board Members** – Trustee Stuber said that there is an open seat on the Board, so if someone is interested, they should contact a Board member or President Murphy.

**Park Board** – Brian Booher said the Cooperative Agreement was approved by the Park Board with the changes that were made. There has been a lot of work being done in the parks, and the help of the Public Works Department is appreciated. Marcia Gates said she helped on park clean-up day. Trustee Stuber said that every volunteer hour saves the Park District \$29.

There is a Special Meeting scheduled for Monday, June 27, 2022 at 6pm, and the business items will be carried over to that agenda since there is no quorum present to vote.
