**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7 OF THE
TOLONO MUNICIPAL CODE AS IT RELATES TO
STOP SIGNS**

WHEREAS, the Village of Tolono, Champaign County, State of Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is not operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto with full powers to enact ordinances for the benefit of the residents of the Village and the Village previously enacted the Tolono Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village previously adopted Title 7 of the Tolono Municipal Code regulating traffic schedules; and

WHEREAS, the Village previously adopted an ordinance establishing a stop signs schedule; and

WHEREAS, the Village has determined that it is appropriate to update and revise said ordinance to add five-way stop signs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF TOLONO, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. Incorporation Clause. The President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Tolono, Illinois hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference incorporate and make them part of this ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. This Ordinance is to amend Title 7 of the Tolono Municipal Code by amending Schedule V. Stop Signs as provided herein.

Section 3. Ordinance Amendment.

The following stop signs shall be added to the Four-way stop schedule:

- a. South Elizabeth Street and East Marshall Street approaching north, south, east, and west.

The following stop signs shall be removed from the Two-way stop schedule:

- a. South Elizabeth Avenue and East Marshall Street approaching from east and west.

Avenue shall be replaced with Street for South Elizabeth and North Elizabeth in all schedules.

All other portions of the Municipal Code not otherwise amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Superseder and Publication. All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded. A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval, as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.


