**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE V OF THE
TOLONO MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD CHAPTER 54,
SNOW PLOWING AND ICE CONTROL**

WHEREAS, the Village of Tolono, Champaign County, State of Illinois (the “Village”) is a duly organized and existing Village created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is not operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto with full powers to enact ordinances for the benefit of the residents of the Village and the Village previously enacted the Tolono Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village previously adopted Title V of the Tolono Municipal Code regulating Public Works issues; and

WHEREAS, the Village maintains the roadways during snow and ice events; and

WHEREAS, the Village determined that is it necessary and appropriate set a policy for what shall be done by the Village and residents; and

WHEREAS, the Village has determined that is appropriate to enact an ordinance pertaining to snow plowing and ice control.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF TOLONO, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Incorporation Clause.

The President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Tolono, Illinois hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference incorporate and make them part of this ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose.

This Ordinance is to amend Title V of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Tolono as follows:

Chapter 54 shall be added to define what snow and ice removal maintained by the Village and residents.

Section 3. Ordinance Amendment.

Title V, Chapter 54 of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Tolono is hereby amended to now read, in entirety, as follows:

SNOW PLOWING AND ICE CONTROL

54.01 SNOW PLOWING OPERATIONS BY THE VILLAGE

- A. Snow plowing operations will begin when snowfall accumulation reaches two inches.
- B. The Village will use rock salt and calcium chloride to assist with snow and ice control on roadways. This may be changed from time to time depending on product changes and availability.
- C. Plowing priorities in determined by the Village's snow plowing priority map, which designates streets and routes based on traffic volume and flow, emergency access, and designated emergency snow routes. This map may be revised from time to time.

54.02 STREET PARKING DURING SNOW EVENTS

- A. Parking on Village streets is discouraged during snowfalls of two inches or more to allow for safe and efficient snow removal.
- B. Emergency Snow Routes
 - 1. Parking on designated emergency snow routes, as defined in Chapter 72 Schedule II, after two inches of accumulated snowfall is prohibited.
 - 2. Vehicles parked on emergency snow routes after two inches of accumulated snowfall are subject to be towed at the owner's expense.
 - 3. Vehicle owners may be fined for parking on emergency snow routes after two inches of accumulated snowfall.

54.03 SNOW PLACEMENT

- A. Property owners and residents shall shovel, blow, or plow snow onto their lawn or landscaped areas, not into the street or public rights-of-way.
- B. Placing snow in the roadways creates hazardous conditions and interferes with snow plowing operations.

54.04 ALLEYWAYS

- A. The Village does not provide snow removal services in alleyways.
- B. Access and snow removal in alleyways during winter conditions are the responsibility of adjacent property owners and/or users.

54.05 SIDEWALKS

- A. Property owners and residents are responsible for removing snow and ice from sidewalks adjacent to their property.
- B. Sidewalks should be cleared in a timely manner to ensure safe pedestrian access.

54.99 PENALTY

Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be fined \$100 for each offense; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each and every day on which a violation occurs or is permitted to continue.

Section 4. Superseder and Publication. All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded. A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval, as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.






