

**Village of Tolono  
Planning & Zoning Board  
Regular Meeting  
April 8, 2026**

The Village of Tolono Planning & Zoning Board (“Board”) met on April 8, 2026 in the Police Station, located at 205 E. Main St., Tolono, IL. Chairman Del Boyle called the meeting to order at 6:01pm. Roll call found the following members present: Del Boyle, Nate Harden, Jeanene Edmison, and Jamie Snodgrass. Sean Talbott was absent. Village Clerk Brandy Dalton filled in as Secretary.

All stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS** – No public comments

**APPROVAL OF PRIOR MINUTES** – Motion by Harden, second by Edmison. Motion passed via voice vote.

**PUBLIC HEARING** – The Board held a Public Hearing for input regarding the ordinance to amend the zoning code to allow for appointment of Secretary from outside of the planning and zoning board and to clean up the wording in the municipal code regarding the planning commission and the planning and zoning board.

There were no public comments regarding the ordinance. The board had no objections to the ordinance. They raised concern over being no definition of who shall be the zoning administrator in the new ordinance, as it was defined in the prior ordinance. The board members asked the secretary to get them copies of all the state codes addressed in the ordinance as well as the new chapter 31 municipal ordinance.

**BUSINESS** – Chairman Boyle discussed the plans he gave to the Village Board in regards to the Downtown Plaza and the Village Hall entrance.

Chairman Boyle said that he would like to discuss the zoning map, annexations, ordinances, and the Retail Strategies 5-year plan at the next regularly scheduled meeting on May 13, 2026.

Motion by Snodgrass, second by Edmison to adjourn the meeting at 6:24pm. Motion passed via voice vote.
